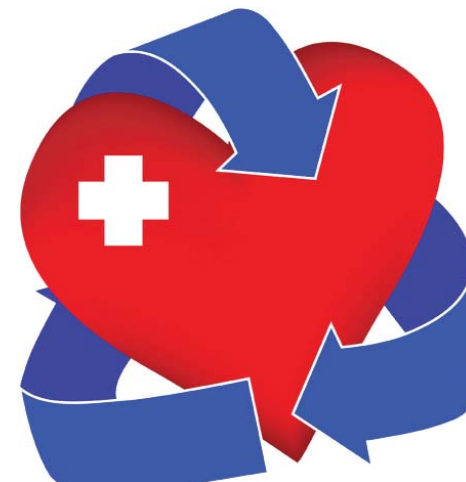

Course Description:

Designed to teach rescuers to effectively recognize and treat adult emergencies in the critical first minutes until emergency medical services personnel arrive. The course includes general principles, medical and injury emergencies.

Intended Audience:

Persons assigned to respond to emergencies in the workplace or community, as well as those who want to learn first aid, CPR, and AED skills. Some rescuers are required to take this course as part of their employer's efforts to comply with OSHA regulations. This course will be combined with Heartsaver CPR and AED training.

HEARTSAVER CPR COURSE

Course Description:

Rescuers learn the skills of CPR and relief of foreign body airway obstruction. The course is divided into two modules.

Adult and Child Module:

- ◆ CPR and relief of foreign body obstruction
- ◆ Chain of survival
- ◆ Signs of arrest, stroke, & choking

Infant Module:

- ◆ CPR and relief of foreign body obstruction
- ◆ Chain of survival
- ◆ Signs of arrest, & choking

Intended Audience:

Lay rescuers, employees, family members of patients at risk for sudden cardiac death, and persons who want to learn rescue skills for loved ones.

AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR

The Heartsaver AED Course teaches the use of this device for children 1 year of age and up to adult. The purpose of the device is to shock the heart into a treatable rhythm.
